



PASSPORT INFORMATION

New U.S. Government security regulations require a valid passport in order to return to the United States from any other country, including Canada. This includes land crossings as well as returning flights. Your tour itinerary requires that you have a current passport.

Have a passport? Take it out now and check the expiration date! The expiration date must be no earlier than February 1, 2016. Don't get caught in the spring with an expired passport or one which expires earlier than February 1, 2016.

No passport? Please do not delay in applying for one. As summer approaches, the U.S. Passport Offices become overburdened and delays are common.

The U.S. Government will make no exceptions to their policy requiring a passport to return to the US!

Birth Certificates will not be accepted.

Routine passport processing time is six weeks. We urge you to start the process now.
